Flower Mound will host the annual National Night Out from 7 to 10 p.m. on Tuesday, August 1, 2006. This is a nationwide initiative encouraging residents to turn their porch lights on and gather outdoors with the rest of the community to send a message to criminals that neighborhoods are organized and ready to fight back.

We invite you to organize a block party in your neighborhood on Tuesday, August 1. Neighborhoods that host parties could receive visits from members of the Town Council, the Flower Mound Police Department, the Fire Department S.A.F.E. Team, and McGruff the Crime Dog. Street barricades will also be provided upon request. More than 2,500 residents participated in last year's National Night Out, and 25 neighborhoods hosted block parties, and we are hoping for even more this year.

Registered parties will be eligible to compete for the Flower Mound Neighborhood of the Year award. Block parties will be judged on participation, activities, theme, spirit, and originality. The winning neighborhood will receive a street sign proclaiming the neighborhood as the 2006 National Night Out Neighborhood of the Year.
